### News from USTA Southern regarding regulation changes

- **National 40 & Over Adult League format change**
  - 40 & over Adult League teams must have minimum roster of 9 players.
  - 1 Singles and 4 Doubles in 2024 at National only
  - Southern has not decided what format will be used after 2024.
    - 2024 1 singles 3 doubles for local and southern
    - We will survey captains to see CORTA's preference.
      - 1 singles and 3 doubles or 1 singles and 4 doubles
- **Tri- level**
  - Tri-Level will become a Southern Sectional Championship in 2024
  - USTA Southern will begin to include Tri-Level results in year-end calculations starting with YEAR END 2024.
- **Mixed Doubles NTRP Levels**
  - In 2024 (Fall 2023) will change from combined levels to straight levels
  - Meaning from 7.0 to 3.5 so 3.5 and 3.0 players can play on a 7.0 team.
  - 2024 Mixed players can only play up one level-similar to adult league)
  - 2024 USTA National will now include Mixed Doubles "dynamics", which means players may be subject to strikes. This includes S, A, M rated players.
- **Suspension Point system documents have been updated.**
